Short-term Japanese Language Program Winter 2023

Meiji University, celebrating its 142nd anniversary in 2023, is a comprehensive university which has received high reputation from home and abroad as one of the "Tokyo Six Universities". Currently, more than 34,000 students, including approximately 1,800 international students, study at the university's ten faculties.

The Japanese Language Education Center will offer a 2-week short-term Japanese language program in February 2023. This program includes not only Japanese language study, but also project work, exchange activities with Meiji University students, and Japanese cultural experiences, which will satisfy your learning needs.

Program Dates February 6 (Mon) – February 17 (Sat), 2022 [2 weeks]

Eligibility

Undergraduate or graduate students of overseas universities

* Students from partner institutions have priority to join.

Program Level & Capacity

Elementary Class : 12 students

Intermediate Class : 12 students

* Classes may be cancelled if it does not reach minimum number (12 in each class).

* More than 12 students per class may be accepted.



Program Fee

JPY80,000

* Included : Tuition, textbooks, bus tour, field trip fees

* Not Included : Accommodation, travel expenses, overseas travel insurance, food, and other living expenses

Accommodation

Participants must make their own arrangements (student dormitory not available)

If you wish to stay at a hotel recommended by the university, please apply once your participation is confirmed.

Travel procedures

Due to the government's boarder measures against covid, changes with entry requirements and visa application procedures may occur. Please be sure to check the entry and VISA requirements for Japan from your country before applying.

Course Level

Elementary Course (JLPT N4, CEFR A2 level)

This course is for students who are JLPT N4 or CEFR A2 level equivalent. Students in this level are able to listen and comprehend conversations encountered in daily life and generally follow their contents, provided that they are spoken slowly.

Students without any experience studying Japanese language are not eligible to apply.

Intermediate Course (JLPT N3-N2, CEFR B1 level)

This course is for students who are JLPT N3~N2 or CEFR B1 level or equivalent. Students in this level are able to listen and comprehend conversations in everyday situations, spoken at near-natural speed, and state his/her own opinion.
