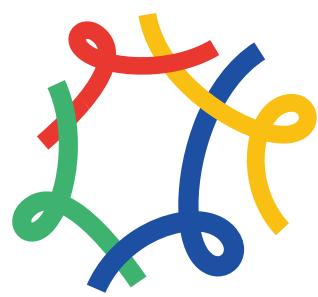

Participant Eligibility:

Undergraduate and graduate students from ASEAN and Korea residing in Korea

- Students residing in ASEAN will have a separate selection process.

NOTE: 20 Korean students will be selected to be a part of the ASEAN-Korea Youth Ambassadors* and will be given the opportunity to join both programs in Korea and Thailand.

* ASEAN-Korea Youth Ambassadors

- The 20 Korean students will be selected through an additional interview process.
- They will serve as ASEAN-Korea Youth Ambassadors until the end of 2016 and be required to participate in other youth activities of the Centre.

1. Accomplish the online application on www.aseankorea.org on or before **June 24, 2016 at 6pm (Friday)**
2. Interview (for ASEAN-Korea Youth Ambassadors only): **June 30, 2016 (Thursday)**
3. Announcement of Successful Applicants: **July 4, 2016 (Monday)**

1. All expenses related to the program will be shouldered by the ASEAN-Korea Centre.
2. Participants will receive a certificate upon the completion of the program.
3. Priority in some of the Centre's programs will be given to ASEAN-Korea Youth Ambassadors.
